Family Ministries Pastor

Purpose:

The Family Ministries Pastor is responsible for overseeing the growth and development of the children's and family ministries of Horizon by equipping children, parents, and volunteers to make and multiply fully devoted followers of Jesus.

Responsibilities:

- Lead the children's ministry program
- Recruit and train ministry volunteers for family-oriented ministries
- Select and prepare teaching curriculum and equip volunteers with needed supplies
- Implement best practices pertaining to care for vulnerable persons
- Implement outreach to families in the neighbourhood

Qualifications:

- An authentic personal relationship with Jesus as King, demonstrated through increasing spiritual maturity and affection for Him
- A love for kids and youth and a desire to see them know and follow Jesus
- Administrative capabilities and personal organization
- A hard-working, servant-hearted approach to pastoral ministry and spiritual leadership
- A humble heart and a desire to learn and grow as a spiritual leader
- A willingness to pursue licensing with the Alliance Canada
- Formal ministry training and/or prior experience is an asset not a requirement

Expanded Role:

This role as described is primarily a Children's Pastor position, for a minimum of 12 hours per week. However, the opportunity exists for this role and the corresponding responsibilities to be expanded into a broader Family Ministries role (up to 24 hours per week) based on the gifts, passions, experience and capacities of a successful applicant. Areas of expanded responsibility may include but are not limited to:

- Leading youth ministry and outreach
- Planning parent/family discipleship opportunities
- Providing greater pastoral care to the congregation
- Serving in a regular role on the teaching/preaching team
- Providing administrative support to the pastoral team
