- Oversee next steps classes, events, and central baptism processes.
- Partner with worship, facilities, and hospitality teams to create a welcoming guest experience.
- Serve as a visible pastoral presence at weekend services and key events.
- Provide general pastoral ministry, including Pastor on Duty support and participation in weddings, baptisms, and funerals as required.
