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Introduction

This profile has been created to provide prospective pastoral candidates with a comprehensive understanding of Heartland Alliance Church (HAC)—its history, current ministry context, community demographics, values, and vision for the future.

This profile reflects months of prayer, research, congregational engagement, and discernment through the Vision Weekend (January 2025), where church leaders and members reflected on God’s work through the years and identified key lessons, blessings, and hopes for the future.

Overview

Heartland Alliance Church (HAC) is a thriving, multi-generational congregation located in Sherwood Park, Alberta—just east of Edmonton—committed to being a community rooted in Jesus, led by His Spirit, and living out His mission.

Over the past two decades, God has blessed Heartland with remarkable growth, a strong teaching and prayer foundation, and a culture deeply invested in serving others generously. The church has experienced several key eras—each marked by God’s provision, refining, and renewed vision. From its early years of rapid growth and enthusiastic service, through the maturing season of expanded ministries and facilities, to recent years of disruption and refining, Heartland has continually sought to remain faithful to God’s call, grounded in His Word and guided by His Spirit.

Today, Heartland is debt-free, stable, and strategically positioned for its next chapter of ministry. The staff and Board of Elders lead with unity and humility, supported by a healthy leadership structure and a passionate volunteer base. The congregation has articulated a clear sense of calling—to deepen its roots in Christ, strengthen discipleship across generations, and extend its reach in the community and beyond.

Heartland is prayerfully seeking a Lead Pastor who embodies both shepherd and visionary—a humble, Spirit-led leader who loves God’s Word, models authentic discipleship, and empowers others to live out the mission of Jesus. This individual will partner collaboratively with the Board of Elders and Senior Leadership Team to guide the church through a new season of Spirit-filled vitality, community impact, and growth.

The ideal candidate will:

- Lead with conviction and humility, grounded in Scripture and prayer.
- Equip and develop leaders who multiply ministry across all generations.
- Model collaborative, team-based leadership aligned with the church's strong organizational culture.
- Preach and teach biblically and passionately, fostering spiritual formation in every age group.
- Engage the Sherwood Park community with love, wisdom, and vision—helping Heartland continue to restore its world through the hope of Jesus.

Heartland's next Lead Pastor will join a church family that is healthy and expectant to move forward "ALL IN" on mission with Jesus.

About Heartland

Who Were We? – A Brief History of Heartland Alliance Church

Heartland Alliance Church began in 2004 in Sherwood Park, Alberta, after God gave a vision of planting another Church in Sherwood Park to a small but passionate group of believers from Sherwood Park Alliance Church. Eager to see a new community built around authentic faith, biblical teaching, and life-changing discipleship, Heartland Alliance Church held its first pre-launch service on July 4, 2004, with 325 people in attendance.

On September 12, 2004, Heartland Alliance opened its doors for the first service in its leased location on Premier Way. Within weeks a second service was added to accommodate the swell in attendance as 500 people called Heartland their church home. Within eight months, a Saturday evening service was initiated to make room for the growing number of people seeking God. Average attendance continued to grow and in August of 2014 Heartland moved into its own building on Highway 21 in Sherwood Park with over 1000 people calling Heartland ‘home’.

The story of “how we got here” is a series of intertwining threads involving people who “love God and love people.” Over the past two decades, Heartland has grown into a thriving multi-generational church rooted in the Word of God, responsive to the Holy Spirit, and committed to serving its community.

Era One: The Early Years (2004–2014)

Blessings:

- Extraordinary growth in attendance and ministry reach.
- Unashamed verse-by-verse preaching of the Word.
- Vibrant community life marked by enthusiasm, humility, and prayer.
- Strong culture of service and generosity.
- Tangible provision of land, leaders, and resources.

Learnings:

- Stay anchored to core values and spiritual disciplines.
- Invest early in leadership and structure.
- Be openhanded and trust God’s provision in seasons of rapid change.
- Depend fully on Jesus’ leading and remain adaptable to His direction.

Era Two: The Maturing Years (2014–2019)

Blessings:

- Completion of the new facility—becoming debt-free and positioned for long-term ministry.
- Growth of small groups, youth, and children’s ministries.
- Spirit-led renewal through Encounter God, Holy Spirit, and Prayer Ministries.
- Deepened partnerships with community, district, and county.
- Expansion of volunteer engagement and ministry capacity.

Learnings:

- Small groups are central to Heartland’s DNA—where connection and discipleship happen best.
- Equip and empower lay leaders to shepherd and care for the body.
- Remain attentive to God’s presence and timing—“don’t get ahead of God.”
- Growth brings the need for stronger organizational systems and intentional leadership development.

Era Three: The Disruption Years (2019–2024)

Blessings:

- God’s sustaining grace through pandemic disruption, leadership transitions, and loss.
- Debt-free financial position and strong elder leadership.
- Continued growth in youth ministry and new community connections.
- Renewed humility, perseverance, and spiritual dependence on God.

Learnings:

- God’s sufficiency and sovereignty in times of uncertainty.
- Pruning is painful but produces fruit—trust His refining process.
- The importance of rebuilding unity, grace, and healthy discipleship pathways.
- Reaffirming the need for humble, Spirit-led leadership and team collaboration.

Heartland has opportunities for growth both on its current property and through ownership of land in the rapidly developing community of Ardrossan. Vision for these properties include a youth ministry center and a church plant.

Position Summary

The Lead Pastor, in partnership with the Board of Elders and Senior Leadership Team, will be responsible for the overall ministry and vision of Heartland Alliance Church. This includes preaching and teaching, developing and implementing ministry strategies, and equipping and empowering church leadership and members.

Responsibilities

- *Spiritual Leadership*: Provide visionary leadership that aligns with Heartland Alliance Church's mission and values, fostering spiritual growth and discipleship within the congregation.
- *Preaching & Teaching*: Deliver engaging, biblically sound sermons and teachings that inspire and equip believers, preaching 2-3 times per month.
- *Leadership Development*: Identify, develop, empower, and mentor current and emerging leaders within the church.
- *Team Leadership*: Work collaboratively with the Board of Elders, Senior Leadership Team, and ministry leaders to implement church initiatives and community engagement.
- *Church Planting & Expansion*: Lead with an entrepreneurial, apostolic spirit, seeking opportunities to reach more people with the love of Jesus and planting new churches to expand the Kingdom.
- *Professional Development*: Seek opportunities for personal growth and professional development and encourage the pastoral team to do the same.

- A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Theology or Biblical Studies; a Master of Divinity (MDiv) degree is an asset.
- Ordination or eligibility for ordination within the Christian and Missionary Alliance (C&MA) is required.

- Demonstrated ability to preach and teach effectively.
- Strong pastoral care skills and a heart for serving others.
- Proven leadership skills with the ability to motivate and inspire others.
- Demonstrated success in leading multiple staff within a growing church.
