Position Summary

The Youth Worship Coordinator is responsible for discipling youth through worship by coordinating and leading worship experiences that cultivate a culture of Spirit-led, Christ-centered, student-empowered praise. This role works closely with the Youth Pastors and Worship Department to develop student worship teams and create environments that engage youth in meaningful worship.

Role responsibilities:

Youth Ministry Development

- Support the vision and implementation of disciple-making among youth.
- Plan & develop worship for youth gatherings, events, and retreats in collaboration with the Youth Team.
- Recruit, equip, and mentor youth worship team members (vocalists, instrumentalists, tech volunteers).
- Coordinate worship team scheduling, rehearsals, and team development.
- Oversee logistics and technical needs for youth worship services, including sound, lighting, and media.
- Support the Youth Pastor in providing pastoral care for students.

General Responsibilities

- Contribute to a thriving, growing, and Christ-centered West Campus culture.
- Partner with Youth Pastors in stewarding ministry plans and budgets effectively.
