






THIS IS US

Our vision and strategy

This past transitional season has provided the opportunity for our Leadership team to look to God to ask "Oh Lord, what shall we do, where shall we go. After a robust time of prayer, listening, conversation and discernment, the team discerned that God was giving leading forward with a new vision statement which reads:

We will be a vibrant church for the city, igniting hope and transformation and mobilizing everyone to courageously follow Jesus.

This statement emphasizes once again the cultural brushstrokes of what makes UDAC strong and provides the framework to inform us of how we should step forward in the coming seasons for the Church. It provides clarity for where and what the ministry of the Church is going to be as we desire to minister in the Lethbridge area.

Key emphasis of the vision statement would include:

- 1. **VIBRANCY:** This is rooted in our missions work in Costa Rica and the desire to see the obedience and intentional living for Jesus transposed from our Latin American friends back here to Canada.
- 2.**FOR THE CITY:** An intentional focus to serve all of Lethbridge and live into the call of Jeremiah 29:4-7.
- 3. **TRANSFORMATION:** A desire to help people go deeper with Jesus. To experience his touch and leading in their lives so that they can live into the new life that He has for them.
- 4. **MOBILIZING EVERYONE:** An intergenerational, intercultural church, engaged and involved, worshipping and serving the Lord.
- 5. **COURAGEOUSLY:** Pursuing Jesus, even when there is great cost. We will go all in to make Him famous-for His glory and our joy.

The strength of our Vision Statement is that it works in compliment to our Mission Statement which says: To exalt Jesus as Savior and Lord, Therefore, in HIs power while demonstrating His love we will reach, teach and equip people to know, love and serve Him. Let Lethbridge grab your heart!


Our City:
