RLAC is a Christ-centered, multi-generational church in Calgary, Alberta, whose members come from diverse ethnic backgrounds. With a strong foundation of over 30 years of Christian service, RLAC is part of The Alliance Canada and is committed to worship, discipleship, and mission.

Our Youth Ministry (Next Gen) service is held on Fridays at 7:00 PM for youth ages 12-18, grades 7-12.

Our Children's Ministry serves kids up to age 11 during the main services.

Our Facilities & Future Growth:

RLAC's main church facility can comfortably seat 150 people, providing ample space for worship services, multiple gatherings, and midweek ministry activities. The building also accommodates external renters and tenants for various community and faith-based activities.

The church is supported by an annual budget of over \$600,000, reflecting strong stewardship and the faithful generosity of our congregation. Looking ahead, we plan to modernize our facilities and expand their use — creating new opportunities for outreach, discipleship, and community engagement as we grow.

Our Location:

Our church is located at 14910 Bannister Road SE, Calgary, Alberta, in a growing suburban area of the city in Midnapore.

- Population: ~6,900 residents; median age in late 30s to early 40s
- Cultural diversity: Visible minorities make up about 14%, including Filipino, Black or African heritage, Chinese, South Asian, Latin American, Arab, Southeast Asian, Korean, Indigenous, and multiracial backgrounds.
- Household income: Median household income is approximately \$84,000–90,000, within the city's middle-income range.
- Community profile: Mostly single-family homes and a suburban character ideal for families and newcomers.

Calgary, with over 1.4 million residents, is a diverse, fast-growing urban centre anchored by industries like energy, finance, tech, education, and tourism. The city offers an excellent environment for ministry, family life, and outreach opportunities in a multicultural context.



Brief Description of the Role:

The Lead Pastor is a loving shepherd and gifted teacher who deeply cares for the church and its members. As the spiritual leader, this role is rooted in a Christ-like love that guides the congregation with wisdom, compassion, and unwavering faith. The Lead Pastor is called to preach, teach, and nurture a community built on love, spiritual growth, mutual support, and outreach. This role requires someone who can genuinely connect with people from diverse backgrounds, offering pastoral care, leading worship, and fostering meaningful relationships. In addition to spiritual leadership, the Lead Pastor must also manage the operational aspects of the church with care and diligence, including staff oversight, budgeting, and strategic planning.

Key Responsibilities:

- Preach & oversee weekly worship services.
- Provide relevant teaching sessions to the congregation as needed.
- Provide leadership for the church alongside the Board of Elders & Pastoral Staff.
- Lead the pursuit of the Vision and execution of the Mission of the church.
- Provide mentorship to both Board of Elders & Pastoral Staff.
- Oversee the pastoral care & discipleship of the church.
- Acts as a liaison between the Pastoral & Support Staff and the Board of Elders.
- Lead in motivating & mobilizing the congregation in mission.
- Represent RLAC to the Alliance Canada Denomination and District.

Qualifications:

- A Bachelor of Theology or Bachelor of Ministry degree is required for the Lead Pastor position.
- A Master of Divinity is preferred.
- Ordained and licensed by The Alliance Canada or prepared to pursue licensing and/or ordination with The Alliance Canada.
- Eight years or more working as a pastor with preferably at least three years work experience in a Lead Pastor role.
- Experience utilizing MS Office suite of products.
